Our doctors also share digital access to patients' medical records to better coordinate their care, ensuring the best health outcomes for veterans.

Our Mid-Atlantic doctors will even help veterans submit Nexus letters for disability care so they get the support they deserve.

Kaiser Permanente has been caring for veterans since World War II, when we partnered with the Veterans Administration to provide care to hundreds of veterans with tuberculosis. In a speech at the closing of the war, Henry J. Kaiser expressed his belief that every veteran deserves to return home to a stable job and peace of mind, and proposed several housing projects that provided immediate employment for thousands.

Since then, we've actively hired veterans in all capacities to support programs like MEDIHC: Military Experience Directed Into Health Careers, because we recognize the value of veterans during and after their service. Today, nearly 600 of our Mid-Atlantic providers are veterans.
