

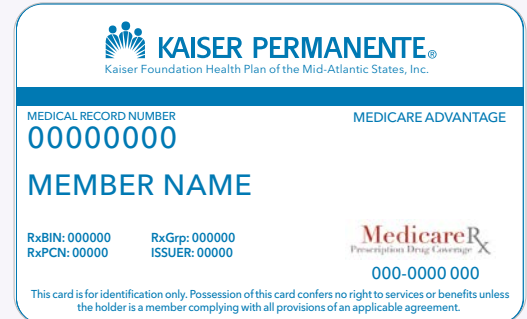
3 EASY STEPS

GETTING STARTED WITH KAISER PERMANENTE

Need help getting started?

A new member onboarding agent will call to help you get started. You can also call our New Member Activation Desk at **1-855-392-4851 (TTY 711)**, Monday through Friday, 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. Our onboarding agents can help you choose a doctor, register on **kp.org**, transfer your prescriptions, and make your first doctor's appointment in person or by phone or video.¹



1 Register at **kp.org**

Visit **kp.org**, your online gateway to great health, where you can:

- Email your doctor's office
- View most lab results
- Schedule routine appointments
- Refill prescriptions, and so much more²

2 Choose your doctor

Browse our online doctor profiles at **kp.org/doctor** to choose an available Kaiser Permanente physician. You can switch to another available Kaiser Permanente doctor at any time.

3 Transfer your prescriptions³

Visit **kp.org/newmember** to transfer your prescriptions. Have this info ready:

- Your prescription number(s)
- Your pharmacy's name and phone number

Make your first appointment

Make an appointment with your new doctor by visiting **kp.org/appointments** or calling the New Member Activation Desk at **1-855-392-4851 (TTY 711)**, Monday through Friday, 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. Choose our convenient virtual care options and visit with your doctor by phone or video.¹

Prescription refills

After your prescriptions have been transferred, you can get refills by mail by signing into your **kp.org** account.⁴ Or call the prescription refill line at **1-800-700-1479 (TTY 711)**.
